- 1. 7 online tutorials.
 - a. 5 are from Invitrogen (do not do the Attune tutorial); <u>Life</u> <u>Technologies Fluorescence and Flow Cytometry</u> <u>Tutorials</u>
 - b. 1 from BD Biosciences about the instrument BD Biosciences Introduction to Flow Cytometry
 - c. 1 more from Biolegends. <u>Multicolor Flow</u> <u>Cytometry: The Brilliant Violet Family of</u> <u>Fluorophores</u> (Kelly Lundsten; BioLegend)
 - d. Included is a link about compensation. This is helpful if you are doing more than 1 color. <u>Compensation, an</u> informal perspective (Mario Roederer; modified May 24, 2000)
